FOLLOW THESE SIX STEPS



FILE A PETITION or **MOTION** with the court to request relief or intervention.



SERVE the other party with court paperwork so that the motion can proceed.



Attend a brief **PRELIMINARY HEARING** to establish issues such as custody, visitation and access to property while awaiting a final resolution.



DISCOVERY – the process by which you and your attorney obtain information relevant to your case.



MEDIATION – a dispute resolution method in which a neutral party, a mediator, goes back and forth between the parties to try to resolve the issue. Mediation is **NON-BINDING**.



FINAL HEARING – both parties and their attorneys present evidence and testimony before the court, and the judge will make a decision that is binding on both parties.
